Information for foreign applicants

Foreign applicants from an EEA country and Switzerland:

Not later than after the expiry of three months from the moment of settling in Austria, citizens of EEA countries or Switzerland must request a confirmation of registration (Anmeldebescheinigung) from the competent district administration authority*.

Foreign applicants not requiring a visa to enter Austria:

Entry into Austria should occur shortly before the admission examination. After the admission examination has been passed successfully, the applicant must immediately request a residence permit – student (Aufenthaltsbewilligung – Studierender) to be issued by the competent district administration authority*. The residence permit can only be granted for the duration of the legally permitted visa-free stay in Austria.

Foreign applicants requiring a visa to enter Austria:

- 1. An application for a visa to participate in the admission examination must be made to the competent Austrian professional representation body = embassy or consulate general.
- 2. After undergoing the admission examination and not later than the visa expiry date, the applicant must return to his/her homeland.
- 3. If the admission examination was passed successfully, the applicant must request a residence permit student to be issued by the competent Austrian professional representation body. This application requires a confirmation of the student's successful passing of the admission examination. This confirmation is issued by <u>studien.office@kunstuni-linz.at</u>.
- 4. If the applicant is granted a residence permit by the competent district administration authority*, he/she may enter Austria with a visa.
- 5. The residence permit is issued in Austria by the competent district administration authority*.

We would like to emphasise that it is within the exclusive competence of the competent district administration authority* to approve or reject your application as the case may be.
